Raymond Chan, Wine Reviews "Firm and concentrated, with blackberry and blueberry flavors that mingle with muscular tannins, black tea notes and a thread of minerality that adds a savory element. Fresh herb details emerge on the finish. Drink now through 2025."

"A dense multifaceted nose from this quality North Canterbury producer reveals notes of black cherries, peppery herbs, violets, vanilla, warm stones and a slightly meaty funky nuance. Sturdy and relatively thick waisted, the palate is cinched with savory tight-grained tannins and a sweet brambly berry fruit ecked with herbal notes to finish. Drink now through 2026."

"Really nice bouquet of Pinot Noir with a complex toasty, nutty, oak layers between aromas of red berries and a savoury mineral core. Dry on the palate, packed with flavours of red berries, dark plum and savoury oak spices - the complexity continues through the palate. Abundant fine tannins and acidity to match. Youthful, fresh, firm and tasty. A wine that will continue to age well for some time. Best drinking 2021 through 2029."

"It is gorgeously fruited and expressed on the nose showing dark cherry, spiced plum, floral and almond characters with hints of game and mushroom. The palate is concentrated and refined, displaying lovely fruit purity together with subtle savoury nuances, beautifully framed by polished tannins. Wonderfully composed and styled. At its best: now to 2025."

"Moderately deep red colour with ruby hues, lighter on the rim. The nose is soft and somewhat restrained in expression, showing light aromas of dark-red cherry and berry fruit along with delicate nuances of fresh herbs, red florals and nutty oak. The aromatics build in depth with aeration. Medium-bodied, the palate has medium-deep flavours of red cherry and berry fruit along with subtle notes of fresh herbs, some light, nutty oak, unfolding lifted red florals. Serve with poultry and pork over the next 4 years."
