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2019 Chardonnay

92 Points

"This is a classy Chard from the cool climes of North Canterbury. It's a rich, concentrated wine but one with depth and elegance. It takes its time opening, gradually revealing melon and grapefruit, backed by subtle toasty oak spice and wet stone mineral nuances. As it warms the fruit really sits in the driver's seat. The palate is highly textural and buoyed by crystalline acidity. Drink now."

2019 Riesling

93 Points

This is a straightforward and delicious Riesling from North Canterbury, a region that excels at the variety. The nose is a subtle combo of lemon-lime and grapefruit with whispers of kerosine and honeysuckle. The palate is off-dry, but there are heaps of bright acidity, so the sweetness isn't pronounced. Fresh, juicy, floral and begging for a Thai curry.

2019 Pinot Noir

92 Points

"Refreshment is the name of the game at this North Canterbury winery, located in the Waipara Valley, just north of Christchurch. The nose is heady and perfumed: vivid cherries, strawberries and florals, with whispers of white pepper, river stones, and vanilla bean. The medium weight palate is similarly vibrant, leading with fresh, silky red berries framed in savory tannins. Not the world's most complex Pinot but totally delicious nonetheless. Drink now slightly chilled."

"This aromatic version showcases preserved lemon, melon and plump apricot notes, backed by hints of tangerine and lemon zest. Reveals a thread of minerality on the sleek, juicy finish."

2022 Sauvignon Blanc Black Label

94 Points

Very attractive bouquet filled with scents of ripe apple and cape gooseberry. There's a lees and mineral quality at the core adding breadth and complexity. Youthful, floral and nicely pungent. Delicious on the palate - a wine with as much texture as it has flavours. Plenty of acidity for crunch and spreading flavour throughout the palate. A wine that finishes as it begins, with an attractive bouquet and textured fruity and varietal palate. Best drinking from 2023 through 2028.
